Service Committees

It takes more than a good set of officers to make a club successful. Your Ohio Federation Board members have the following committees in place at the state level. While these committees function at the state level, you can make them work in your community.

Agriculture & Natural Resources:

To promote agriculture, oil and gas programs. Act as a liaison to community based organizations within the state.

Armed Services:

Promote and encourage clubs to have a robust outreach program in support of all branches of the military both active and retired.

Campaign:

Work with the Ohio Republican Party and the National Federation of Republican Women to develop strategies that assist the candidates. Develop campaign presentations for the general membership, utilizing state and national resources.

Community Engagement:

Identify and develop outreach programs for local clubs within their communities.

Government Affairs and Advocacy:

Develop methods to advocate issues and work with the campaign committees. Work with Ohio business and industry to establish relationships and educate the membership.

Homeland Security:

Provide training to all OFRW members on such subjects as prevention, preparation and protection.

Leadership Development:

Work to facilitate officer training and development of leadership skills within clubs.

Literacy:

Promote literacy programs for all OFRW groups. Work to identify opportunities to champion literacy.

Membership:

Develop and implement strategies for membership growth while focusing on new members and membership retention.

Next Generation:

Develop a plan to attract young women into club memberships.

Political Education & Legislation:

Educational and informational source for issues and legislation in the local, state and national arena.

Publicity:

Develop information for the OFRW activities and events. Press releases are available to attendees after OFRW events for local publications. Keep the public informed of the OFRW participation in Club and Republican activities.

Social Media and Technology:

Utilize all aspects of social media to enhance communication.

Social Services:

Provides opportunity to impact your community.

Voter Issues:

Educate the membership on issues that are on the upcoming ballot and changes in the voting process.

Women In Business:

Work to develop a statewide networking directory for OFRW members. Monitor and inform membership on legislation.
